KEY OUTCOMES OF THE SESSION

- 1. Identification of potential areas for future protection in the region and by countries (MPAs, Natura/EMERALD, OECMs...) and plans for improvement of transboundary management effectiveness of existing MPAs.
- 2. Proposal for **establishment of the Action plan at TSG3 level with clear objectives in supporting identification and designation of MPAs**, capacity development and networking.
- **3. Reinforcement of existing national activities** of partners/countries in combination with new **transnational/macroregional approaches** (blue and green) corridors, ecosystem services, charismatic species, interaction with other sectors, climate change process, new partnerships, innovative activities/tools.
- 4. Extension of existing networks (national MPAs, NATURA 2000 & EMERALD networks) & transboundary management (i.e. EGTC) with possible combination of different legal basis and instruments (i.e., Strait of Bonifacio case / MPAs/NATURA 2000 & EGTCs, SPAMI, PSSA).
- 5. To achieve long-term conservation goals and at the same time **establishing a legal instrument for transboundary MSP** in a coherent manner to ensure ecosystem-based management aiming at both biodiversity protection and sustainable economic development.



Cooperation between TSG3 and PAP/RAC

Meeting in Split on 11-12 April 2022 between EUSAIR TSG3 Pillar Coordinators and PAP/RAC.

The scope of the meeting:

- 2. Proposal of project ideas for the next period Coordination of contributions to the EUSAIR Forum

Main Conclusions:

- At the *Mediterranean Coast and Macroregional Strategies Week* that will be held in September 2022, the Municipality of Izola will organise a Workshop where **PAP/RAC will present its activities** on climate change adaptation, AdriAdapt and MSP Workspace *point 3*.
- The meeting calls for strengthening and focusing MCSD partnerships in order to support the
 implementation of priorities and challenges for healthy coast and sea at sub-regional, national and
 local levels.
- PAP/RAC welcomes the active role of local communities, and in particular the involvement of the Municipality of Izola, in supporting the Barcelona Convention implementation thought the TSG3 EUSAIR Pillar. Proposal is made for the future with several activities, in particular for the Trieste Bay pilot area, the road deviation in the tunnel between Koper and Izola, the CAMP Bosnia and Hercegovina (Klek-Neum Bay), as well as the Jabuka Pit and the Otranto Channel as transboundary MPA.









Project structure:

As a result of preparatory activities, the CAMP B&H is designed to encompass two major components with a set of activities and sub-activities:

A. Horizontal activities

- 1. Project Co-ordination, integration and dissemination of results
- 2. Capacity building/Awareness raising
- 3. Spatial Data Infrastructure/Information system/Data management

B. Individual activities integrated into Coastal Plan

- 1. Institutional mechanism for ICZM
- Marine habitats and protected area
- 3. Monitoring marine and coastal environment
- 4. National Contingency Plan
- 5. Sustainable tourism: coastal hinterland
- 6. Climate change adaptation











Project outputs:

The main expected outputs of the CAMP Project for B&H are:

- A Coastal plan for the Project area incorporating inputs of several individual activities;
- Increased capacity of all the stakeholders, especially the local level ones;
- Raised awareness of coastal processes and integrated management;
- Final Integrated Project Report, with proposals for follow-up activities.
- Celebration of Coastal Day in Bosnia and Herzegovina
- 20 project proposals o Sustainable tourism on coastal zine and hinterland
- 5 project proposals on adaptation on climate changes in Neum municipality
