Conference on "Evaluation and preservation of the environment for tourism" is being organized in line with the priorities of the EUSAIR Action Plan jointly including Pillar 3 - Environmental Quality and Pillar 4 Sustainable tourism related to green tourism (taking into account: biodiversity, ecological connectivity, tourism and eco-services). 
