Item 4 – Implementation of the Republic of Slovenia Presidency Programme


GB was informed on the implementation of Slovenian Presidency Programme, which runs smoothly in spite of COVID-19 limitations.

TSGs to be encouraged to provide inputs on the needed support from their side




Item 7 – ADRION Programme
