Conclusions from the Technical meeting of EUSAIR Pillar Coordinators

Patras (Greece), 12 February 2025



Conclusions - 1

- The PCs propose to run the Technical meetings of PCs and GB only in person format twice per year, no hybrid option, in order to motivate active participation of members.
- Guidance on continuation of the labelling process and its updating needs to be discussed at GB.
- Need of a discussion with NCs how to improve participation of TSG members and their responsiveness and active involvement.
- Lack of expertise of TSG members regarding roles expected from GAP for TSG members (ex. funding, embedding, technical processes) – include those needs in capacity building activities.



Conclusions - 2

- 10th Annual forum:
 - The titles of pillar sessions proposed by EL TSG members need to be consolidated and agreed within each TSG. Afterwards should be communicated to the Hellenic Presidency, via common template prepared by Facility Point.
 - Title of the forum appreciated: Bridging horizons strenthening cooperation, cohesion, resilience
 - Proposal of EC and PCs to EL Presidency: the main theme/red thread of the entire forum is the launch of the new Action Plan. EL Presidency will come back with feedback.
 - 10th anniversary (publication request for TSGs inputs)
- NCs were requested to update the TSG lists for their national members by end of January 2025, the updated TSG lists to be published on the EUSAIR intranet by end of February 2025. Afterwards those checks reccommended to be performed once per year.



Conclusions - 3

- The PCs proposes creating a strategic intergenerational dialogue and youth inclusion (effect of decisions taken or not taken on youth and their future).
- Due to lack of time at the PC Technical meeting to address point 6 regarding the Monitoring and Evaluation Terms of Reference the the Presidency proposed to follow the presentation at the 24th GB meeting and have the document approved via GB written procedure, launched after the GB meeting.
