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The Transport Community: a game changer for Western Balkans

What is the Transport Community about? Moving from transport cooperation to transport integration

- Promoting transport policies aligned with the EU ones;
- Supporting the transposition and implementation of EU's transport and transport related legislation in Western Balkans.
- Sharing the same goals but also the same values.
- Opening (under conditions) the EU transport market to Western Balkans countries, before their accession = fostering the accession process.
- In other words, the Transport Community is a game changer for the region to fill the transport gap between Western Balkans and EU and prepare WB to the accession.





TCT Priorities

- Derive from Commission's Communication of Feb.
 2018 « on a credible enlargement strategy »;
- Reflect the declarations adopted by the Transport
 Ministers of Western Balkans in April and December

 2018: regional rail strategy road safety transport facilitation.
- Supported by the Permanent Secretariat of TCT and...
- Implemented by the <u>Regional Partners!</u>





Transport Community: 4 principles applied to projects

- Enabler of projects: sets the conditions for a infrastructure priority to become a successful project.
- Supports a transport system at the service of citizens and business, not to help building « cathedrals in the desert ».
- TCT promotes the transport of tomorrow not the solutions of the past.
- TCT supports long term vision not only short term actions.





Priority #1 for TCT : Developing a Regional Rail Strategy

No fatality in the decline of rail transport in WB!

- Sharp decline in both passenger and freight;
- Poor quality standards (low speed low service levels...);
- Fragmentation of the markets (small networks many borders!), market opening still incomplete: no real competition!
- Lack of cooperation between railways.
- Administrative capacity missing to implement EU standards/legislation;
- Against such background what TCT can do?





Priority #2 for TCT : road safety

- References: (1) declaration adopted by all WB Ministers of Transport in April 2018 (2) TCT listed legislation.
- Permanent Secretariat's role: to monitor the situation – to set realistic objectives for each partners – to provide support – to ensure the coordination of T.A in the region.
- Implementing a **Regional Road Safety Action Plan** is the priority for 2020.
- The **Action Plan** will comprise a list of priority mesures in addition to the ones already in place
 - to be set up by each partner and the timing for implementation;





Priority #3 for TCT : transport facilitation

- Truck queing at borders = 2 € x minute
- Loses for Western Balkans = 250 M€ per year (5 times the amount spent for road maintenance in the region)
- Making border crossing more efficient: removing infrastructure and administrative bottlenecks
- Action covers rail and road, inside WB and border crossing with MS
