### THE EU MACROREGIONAL STRATEGY

A 'Macroregional strategy' is an integrated framework endorsed to address common challenges faced by a defined geographical area relating to Member States and third countries located in the same geographical area which thereby benefit from strengthened cooperation contributing to achievement of economic, social and territorial cohesion.







## THE EUSAIR STRATEGY

- to promote economic growth and cohesion in the region by improving its attractiveness, competitiveness and connectivity
- 4 EU and 5 non-EU Countries for contributing to further integration of the Western Balkans.

- Contribute to build up one cohesive and connected European Region, sharing actions and solutions for sustainable transport
- Stimulate policy dialogue between decisionmakers, industries, universities and the civil society in the Adriatic-Ionian Region

### Art.6 Catania Declaration (III EUSAIR Forum)

#### Proposed Priorities for EU programming period 2021-2027

1. Harmonised, environmental-friendly and inclusive maritime transport system in the Adriatic-Ionian Region

a) Boost transport digitalization promoting e-Maritime and VTMIS solutions to simplify and streamline procedures and processes of maritime and intermodal transport at the regional scale;

b) Support the implementation of ICT infrastructure at nodes and along logistics chains, as well as systems interoperability in the Adriatic-Ionian region;

c) Deploy telematic applications to improve safety and security of transport operations.

#### Proposed Priorities for EU programming period 2021-2027

# 2. Competitive, seamless intermodal connections for freight and passenger transport in the Adriatic-Ionian Region

a) Reduce infrastructural gaps and improve accessibility across the Adriatic-Ionian region, by means of construction and improvement/upgrading of the TEN-T network, according to the standards foreseen by Reg.
(EU) 1315, with particular attention to the coastal areas of the region and the intermodal connections in the ports of the Adriatic Sea.

b) Facilitate cross-border traffic flows and transport operations in the Adriatic-Ionian region.

c) Strengthen North-South and East-West physical and digital interconnections between the logistics and urban nodes of the Adriatic-Ionian region to facilitate exchange between, on the one hand, long-distance global and EU flows, on the other hand, regional and local traffic.
