### **EUSAIR**

- EU MRS adopted by the European Commission and endorsed by the European council in 2014
- It covers nine countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Greece, Italy, Montenegro, Serbia, Slovenia and North Macedonia,
- General objective: to promote economic and social prosperity and growth in the region by improving tis attractiveness, competitiveness and connectivity
- Countries aim to create synergies and foster coordination among all territories of the EUSAIR Region
- Strategic project for implementation multi-pillar model
   (80% responsible for the pillar they coordinate, 20% for national representatives in other three pillars)

## **EUSAIR: 4 pillars**

### EUSAIR, Pillar 4, Sustainable tourism

The **specific objectives** for this pillar are:

- Diversification of the macro-region's tourism products and services along with tackling seasonality of inland, coastal and maritime tourism demand (products and services: 8 indicative actions/actors, examples of possible projects)
- Improving the quality and innovation of tourism offer and enhancing the sustainable and responsible tourism capacities of the tourism actors across the macro-region
  - (innovation and quality:7 indicative actions/actors, examples of possible projects)
- → ensuring the <u>integrated sustainability</u>: strong links to the other three pillars
- → <u>cross-cutting issues</u>: research and innovation, capacity building-education, communication to wider and specific audiences

### MONO PILLAR PROJECT CONCEPTS

Mono-pillar project ideas:

TOPIC: Sustainable and Responsible Tourism Management

- > Green Mapping: Support to the development of sustainable and responsible tourism and entrepreneurs in the EUSAIR area;
- > DES\_AIR: Integrated sustainable management of tourist destinations; Development of lifelong learning training programs and masters programs in EUSAIR
- > Cruise Air: Promoting and supporting development of special interest tourism cruising tourism

TOPIC: Diversified Tourism Offer

- CultourAir: EUSAIR Cultural Tourism Demand Survey; improved statistical monitoring of cultural tourism(methodology) for sustainable and responsible management of tourism product
- > Air Cultural Routes: Development of sustainable and thematic macro-regional routes

# Manual for participatory tourism connecting community and culture through storytelling

- ➤ Providing sustainability of EUSAIR's <u>intangible heritage</u>, through implementation of the participatory tourism storytelling model using EUSAIR intangible heritage
- ➤ Providing specific <u>instructions</u> and <u>recommendations</u> for users.
- ➤ Workshops to be organized (post COVID-19) to assist destinations in providing interdisciplinary cooperation between the academic and private sectors, networking with the local community, tourism, hospitality and cultural sectors

### **Routes 4U**

#### Multidisciplinary cooperation and support

**Priorities -** TSG4 identified and supported with actions two priorities: Routes of the Olive Tree and the Roman Heritage Route.

#### **Results:**

- >Macro-regional event in Mali Lošinj, November 2018
- ➤ Publication TSG4 supported data for the <u>study launched on Roman</u>
  Heritage Route and <u>identification of partners</u> for the establishment of a legal network
- ➤ Revival of the Olive Tree Route resulted in 26 new members in Greece, 31 in Croatia and 24 in Slovenia

### Cooperation with other EUSAIR Pillars

- >Four cross-pillar projects proposals, one pending
- ➤ Joint event in 2019:

TSG3 and TSG4: "Evaluation and Preservation of Environment for Tourism", September 2019, Poreč(CRO) and Izola (SLO)

\*UNWTO- active participation in our thematic events (regional workshop in Zagreb "The Present and the Future of Sustainable and Responsible Tourism" and TSG3 &TSG4 event in 2019)

- >ADRIONCYCLETOUR, "ADRiatic IONian CYCLE route for sustainable TOURism"- with Pillar 2, Connecting the region, subgroup on transport
- For People, for Planet, new proposal, Pillars 2,3,4 Agenda 2030 & Green Deal pending approval

### **OECD** Synthesis report –issues in implementing MRS

**EUSAIR:** multi-level governance structural challenges

- Enhancing national EUSAIR multi-level governance structures and existing coordination mechanisms would contribute to stronger implementation capacity.

#### What should be done:


- a clearer attribution of responsibilities and expectations between EUSAIR and EU programming authorities in all participating countries; probably valid for all MRS
- better harmonising expectations from distinct coordinating groups;
- breaking down silos within the pillar structures; how about different MRS?
- holding regular national cross-sector EUSAIR meetings with key national and subnational actors; cross-strategies meetings?
- and developing stronger ties with peers in other macro-regional strategies.
