

- Setting priorities through an inclusive process of stakeholders' involvement centered on "entrepreneurial discovery"
- A broad view of innovation (technological, practice-based and social innovation)
- Providing incentives to private Research & Innovation investments

- Other Key Enabling Technologies (KETs)


