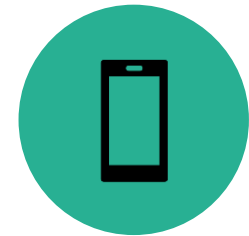

Priorities of Slovenian Fisheries Sector

- Preservation and development - **long-term sustainability and resilience** of the sector;
- State of shared migratory stocks – available fishing resources and **environmentally sustainable exploitation**;
- Ensuring good socio-economic condition of the sector;
- Principle of proportionality and already done actions when addressing environmental aspects and goals;

EUSAIR Flagships on Pillar 1

Better management and sustainable exploitation of fish stocks. Improvement of data collection and fish stock assessment. Harmonization with EU regulations & international organizations

-Compliance & implementation of measures to combat illegal, unreported, unregulated fisheries and elimination of destructive fishing practices;

-Utilization of Unwanted and Unavoidable catches and discards;

Increase of aquaculture production. Improvement of productivity, quality, environmental sustainability and diversification in aquaculture. Introduction of new species, use of alternative raw materials for feed production, new farming technologies, use of advanced processing technologies and innovative actions on traceability

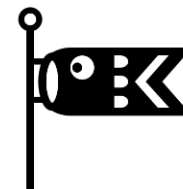
-Improvement of the image and competitiveness of farmed products including the promotion of initiatives on marketing standards and healthy nutritional habits;

-Plans to improve professional skills of fishermen

-Acquisition and improvement of professional skills

EUSAIR Flagships on Pillar 1

Strengthening FISHERIES and AQUACULTURE in the region:



Projects (with EUSAIR labels) that contribute to common goals identified on regional level.

EMFAF OP 2021-2027 and macroregional projects

- National OPs – national priorities;
- Inclusion of EUSAIR regional goals in national OPs and priorities;
- Coordinated approach:
 - Coordination from the EC and cooperation between EMFAF MA;
 - Harmonised tenders between MS and avoid of doublefundings;
 - Project partners from multiple countries;
 - Implementation and financing of the projects in multiple countries;
 - Durability of the projects and result indicators;
 - Direct VS shared management;

Contribution of the EMFAF OP 2021-2027 to the EUSAIR

- Supporting actions for:
 - management and monitoring of marine protected areas
 - pilot projects
 - marine knowledge
 - studies in connection to aquaculture sector & promotion
 - CLLD
