- Preservation and development long-term sustainability and reseilance of the sector;
- State of shared migratory stocks available fishing resources and environmentally sustainable exploitation;
- Ensuring good socio-economic condition of the sector;
- Principle of proportionality and already done actions when adressing environmental aspects and goals;
