It is hoped that private vaccinations will be available in most countries soon but until they are caution should be used if vaccines are offered by




Top 10 Countries supplying seafarers








Evolution in employment in shipping


























Maritime ecosystem > to match supply and demand globally, efficient and effective cargo, information and financial flows are interconnected in a variety of multi-layered networks linking all actors (B2B, B2G) (living components) and infrastructure (e.g. port, hardware,...) (non-living components) whilst reducing costs, improving (operational) efficiency, ensuring sustainability, complying with regulation and simultaneously improving customer satisfaction (e.g. reliability) to retain or increase market share. 


