

SO 2.1: Enhancing resilience to climate change, natural and man-made disasters in the A-I region

- Develop, implement, and promote transnational climate change adaptation strategies, plans and test solutions with a focus on people's health, preservation of natural and cultural heritage and urban areas.

# SO 2.3: Supporting environment preservation and protection in the A-I region



- Biodiversity protection and preservation
- Green and blue infrastructures
- Sustainable soil, fishery and aquaculture management;
- Environmental pollution reduction
- Tourism environmental impact reduction



- Sustainable tourism through participatory approaches and multi-level governance;
- Sustainable food and traditional agricultural products (e.g.: old seeds, traditional animal breeding etc.) as well as support to km 0 food chain and food safety and quality;
- Develop and implement joint strategies on Adriatic and Ionian seas to safeguard biodiversity considering the sea conflicting exploitation: tourism, commercial and recreational shipping, aquaculture plants, settlements of offshore wind parks, oil and gas extraction etc.
- Develop measures and test solutions to minimise the tourism environmental impact.
