



### **OUTLOOK ON THE NEXT STEPS**

### **Call 1** - (closed on 23.2.2022)

- All 4 Programme Priorities and all SO open
- Indicative budget of 72 million EUR ERDF
- Funding decision expected for December 2022

### Call 2 - opening in early 2023

- Thematically focused
- Pioneer projects
- Projects and partnerships with smaller size and shorter duration
- Indicative budget of around 10 million EUR ERDF
