	Scope of the workshop: The PET HAB ECO flagship will seek to establish the protection and enhancement of natural terrestrial habitats and ecosystems, with particular attention to the ecological connectivity of blue and green corridors/infrastructure. The overall objective of the Flagship is to improve the resilience of large carnivore populations on a transnational scale in an area characterized by human-dominated or fragmented ecosystems in the face of environmental threats and risks, including those caused by the impacts of climate change. The proposal is fully in line with the EU Strategy for the Adriatic-Ionian Region and its Action Plan. It aims to protect and preservation of terrestrial habitats and ecosystems through the development of joint management plans, especially transboundary habitats and landscape elements that are of key importance for large carnivores. Discussion will focus on potential collaboration with IAR partners to address their local, national, and regional habitat conservation needs and goals regarding protection of LC habitats.	
	The workshop will be fully interactive and will include roundtable presentations from potential partners, including their local and national goals related to the conservation of LC, gapes, local needs, good practices and projects that should be capitalized, proposals of local and transboundary pilot actions to improve the resilience of LC populations, coexistence, management, and ecological connectivity of their habitats.	

Participants will work in smaller groups to contribute to co-creation of SWOT analyses and concrete proposals of PET HAB ECO implementation that consider local, national needs and objectives.

A guided discussion with participants will be held to present group works results and combine them to final results.

Conclusions and final remarks will include identification of possible project partnerships, actions and next steps to develop project ideas.
