Climate change and environmental degradation are an existential threat to the European Union and to the world. To overcome these challenges, European Green Deal is Europe's new strategy, which will transform the Union into a modern, resource-efficient and competitive economy. The European Green Deal aims to make Europe climate neutral by 2050, boost the economy through green technology, create sustainable industry and transport and cut pollution. Turning climate and environmental challenges into opportunities will make the transition just and inclusive for all.

But what are the measures to take the green transition? What is green transition and how is it connected to circular economy? What are the horizontal and vertical measures to foster it? What are the best practices across the region? What are the scenarios of our future with or without the green transition?

The purpose of the event is to build our capacities in terms of existing resources and generate our joint knowledge on how macro regional strategies processes could foster the green transition.

EUSAIR Pillar I: Innovation for Sustainable Blue Economy-Proposal for the organization of thematic session: A. Innovation in the flagships of Pillar I

B. The dimension of multilevel use of maritime Space and climate change monitoring within Pillar I.

Scope

The first session will deploy innovation trends and recommendations in relation to EUSAIR Pillar I flagships, in respect to the implementation of Smart Specialization Strategies through regional cooperation. The discussion will address the quadruple helix stakeholders (public and private sectors, research and academia, citizens):

- F1 - Fostering quadruple helix ties in the fields of marine technologies and blue bio-technologies for advancing innovation, business development and business adaptation in blue bio-economy, covers the priority 1 - Blue technologies.
- F2 Promoting Sustainability, Diversification and Competitiveness in the fisheries and aquaculture sectors through education, research & development, administrative, technological and marketing actions, including the promotion of initiatives on marketing standards and healthy nutritional habits, following priorities 2a - Fisheries and 2b - Aquaculture.
- F3 Bolstering capacity building and efficient coordination of planning and local development activities for improving marine and maritime governance and blue growth services, tackling priority 3 - Maritime and marine governance and services.

The second session will be targeted to present to a wider audience the findings and recommendations of the two (2) Issue Papers, in relevance to the Pillar I flagships:

- Innovation in the multilevel use of maritime space
- ÷. Innovation in climate change cross-border monitoring and recording

They can serve as a validation mechanism to provide feedback on the content, based on the quadruple helix approach.

The Issue papers will be developed by the Innovation Expert FP-GR.
