



- IPA Adrion -> supports EUSAIR -> its post 2020 IPA allocation has been multiplied by **351%** vs 2014-2020
 - -> main purpose: higher degree of territorial integration



72 million inhabitants.




GDP (PPS) is 10% of that of the EU28.



IPA Adrion & EUSAIR MRS facilitating the Enlargement process of the Western Balkan


- A regional dimension that reconnects the WB to the EU;

- An inclusive approach towards stakeholders with participatory processes (consultation, engagement and mobilisation).












Horizon Europe and Cohesion Policy









EUSAIR pillar 1 – Innovation for sustainable blue economy

Main objective:

- Focus on blue technologies, fisheries and aquaculture, maritime and marine governance as well as services.
 - To drive innovative maritime and marine growth in the Region, including Smart Specialization Strategies and flagships projects
- 7 out of the 10 EUSAIR partner countries are bordering on the Adriatic and Ionian Sea:
 - good geography matching with Interreg IPA programmes
 - importance of the 'Green Deal for the Blue Economy'
 - interest in marine-based activities (activities undertaken in the ocean, sea and coastal areas, such as capture fisheries and aquaculture, marine renewable energy or maritime transport) as well as in marine-related activities (such as seafood processing, biotechnology, shipbuilding or port activities).



EUSAIR pillar 1 – Innovation for sustainable blue economy

Potential to contribute more to:

- The 'EU Mission on Ocean and Waters',
 - whose overall objective is to protect 30% of the EU's sea area and to restore marine ecosystems, by for example reducing plastic litter in the sea or by reducing nutrient losses and the use of chemical pesticides by 50%.
- Blue Technologies :
 - strengthening quadruple helix ties in the fields of marine technologies and blue bio-technologies + facilitating the "brain circulation" between universities, institutes and companies + combining fisheries with tourism activities (EUSAIR Pillar 4)
- Maritime and Marin Governance and Services
 - improving the sustainable management of coastal and insular areas (e.g. creation of databases for effective policy-making and the implementation of the Maritime Spatial Planning Directive as well as the Maritime Strategy Framework Directive).
