	The optimal management of water resources is an essential goal considering the impacts that climate change has on the environment. The Covid-19 pandemic has also become an element of further pressure on water resource management, emphasizing the need for a more sustainable and resilient economic, social and environmental system.
	New EU rules on water reuse and initiatives provide excellent conditions for instilling more sustainability and circularity into the water management sector in the near future. Cities and Regions can play a decisive role in guaranteeing full compliance with relevant EU water legislation and for preserving freshwater resources in the long term.
