




Blue Corridors in EU Sustainable blue economy:



Green and Blue Corridors are environmental spatial links of Green Infrastructure areas that maintain or improve biodiversity and/or the supply of ecosystem

services.

Features of Green and Blue Corridors:

- Their basic feature is **connectivity**.
- Green and Blue Corridors make part the infrastructure green network.
- They are recognised on all three levels: micro, mezzo, macro.











GREEN/BLUE cooridors:


Act as a **tool for maritime spatial planning** with the aim to:

ensure good ecological status of Adriatic Sea/Mediterranean Sea

enhance ecosystem services: enhance water, food, biological, energy and climate SECURITY for the healthy future along regional seas

Indicate the most dynamic interactions of the land/coast/sea



ECO-CONNECTIVITY

Land: rivers, lakes, wetlands

Coast: land/sea

Sea: migration of fish stocks and endangered species
