EU C.P. Regulation (EU) 2021/1060 on Skills

The ESF+ (EU Reg. 2021/1057 Skills for a smarter and greener Europe), the ERDF, the Cohesion Fund and the EMFAF shall support the following policy objectives:

- Policy Objective 1: 'a smarter Europe by promoting innovative and smart economic transformation'
 By SO (iv) developing skills for smart specialisation, industrial transition and entrepreneurship;
- Policy Objective 4: 'a more social Europe implementing the European Pillar of Social Rights'
 - **By SO** (i) enhancing the effectiveness of labour markets and access to quality employment through developing social innovation and infrastructure;
 - **By SO** (ii) improving access to inclusive and quality services in education, training and lifelong learning through developing infrastructure;



EUSAIR revised Action Plan towards 2030

Activities on Skills and Partnerships and promoting the EU Pact for Skills:

Pillar 1: Sustainable Blue economy

Topic 1.1 – Blue and green technologies

Through Pact for skills - upskilling shipbuilding and maritime technology workers in Europe

Topic 1.2 – Fisheries and aquaculture

Through Sustainable growth of a more efficient and circular aquaculture production, capitalising on innovation, digitalisation, and knowledge sharing.

Topic 1.3 – Maritime and marine governance and services

By establishing Networks and Clusters of training/education centres/technological and higher education institutes/industry to cooperate in development/sharing of blue skills programmes.

Pillar 4: Sustainable Tourism through the Transition Pathway and industrial ecosystem for Tourism

Pillar 5 Improved Social Cohesion Topic 5.2 – Promoting skills acquisition for future labour markets

EU PACT FOR SKILLS



- European Skills Agenda flagship initiative: large and Regional-scale skills partnerships across all ecosystems *Aim to upskill and reskill the European workforce in green, digital and social skills*
- Support to the Pact for Skills through ERDF +ESF+EMFAF+ other EU funds to ensure coordination over the next years by submitting concrete action pledges with expected results (EU umbrella associations, trade unions, higher education bodies, regional authorities and clusters)
- The RSP on Skills in cooperation with DG Empl., Grow, Mare, Regio: To examine the potential and feasibility to establish a Transition Pathway for Sustainable Blue Economy including all economic, environmental and social UN and EU and MS Policies and scientific aspects in the SBE

- Through the **Networking Hub**, members can find partners and relevant EU tools (like Europass, Skills Panorama, EURES and the European Network of Public Employment Services). They can also promote their activities.
- ➤ The **Knowledge Hub** organizes webinars, seminars and peer learning activities for members. It also provides updates on EU policies and instruments, as well as information on projects, tools, and best practices.
- In the **Guidance Hub**, members can find information about EU and national funding opportunities, and guidance to partnering with national and regional authorities.

EUSAIR RSP on Blue Skills Working Group establishment

Draft Blue Skills Partnership indicative content (<5 pages):

- A) The Challenges (Climate change, Green Deal, Enlargement, demographic trends in coastal communities, brain drain, digitalised economy in fisheries and maritime services, ecotourism and MSP etc)
- B) The Proposal (transformation of the comparative advantages to competitive advantages for better performance objectives through green and digital transition, etc)
- C) The planned activities (Networking activities of pledges promoters, joint EUSAIR flagship interpillar projects P1+P4+P5, targeted VET, postgraduate studies, research, study visits, policies recommendations etc.)
- D) Targets and Key milestones (by year 1,2,3: good practices shared in online training webinars, seminars and guides for EU policies and funding for skills, TSG1, regions, academics and clusters participation in a joint platform, number of Blue skills promoters, etc)
- E) Partnership rules and arrangements (online meetings every 3 months and rotational annual presidency of the working group, etc)
