

Jack Jacometti, Partner, Jacometti Associates and Director, Institute for Integrated Economic Research



As Vice-President of Global GTL Development and subsequently Future Fuels & CO₂, Shell International, since 2001, Jack Jacometti was involved in the shaping of sustainable energy futures based on scenarios, in cooperation with governments, business partners and international institutions. He developed partnerships with governments to promote cleaner fuels and sustainable mobility with e.g. North Rhine Westphalia and the C40 Cities initiative.

His increased awareness of the importance of scenario thinking, and global systemic risks and their interrelatedness (financial, economic, resource depletion, environmental degradation, inequality) led to the establishment of Jacometti Associates, which builds on his global network. He has worked extensively with the European Commission, including the Joint Research Center and is a Director of the Institute of Integrated Economic Research, UK.

He has over 35 years of work experience in commercial, technical, and human resource development fields and holds an MSc Engineering (power generation, including nuclear) from the Technical University Delft.
