He is an Economic Advisor to the Governor of Guangdong Province of China. He is honorary professor at the South China University of Technology in Canton. In the 2010 Award "Commendatore al merito" of the Italian Republic", in 2015 he received from Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei the Award "Minister of Heritage and Culture and Tourism for the political and social sciences". He is the author of several books and publications in International scientific journals.
